I am continually in awe as I see God's moving in our hearts and lives on a day to day basis. As you know, one of our **Project 1.11** goals is for us to raise 55% of our deputation support so we could pursue full-time deputation. While we are continuing to watch God meet our financial needs, He made it clear this month, that He is asking us to step out on faith in pursuit of this goal. On the recommendation of a fellow missionary, I contacted Shepherd's Bethel, a missionary-housing ministry in Indiana to put our names on a waiting list in case a house became available in the next year. Within a week, the ministry called to inform us that a unit was available and it would be ready for us after the children finish their first semester here at BJES. What an unexpected blessing! We honestly thought nothing would be available until later in 2011, but as always, God's ways are not our ways. Have we reached our goal of 55% financial support yet? Not yet -- but that is where the faith comes in. =)

This isn't to say that Michelle and I jumped at this housing opportunity without a thought of the logistics. We are now feverously creating and completing an ever-growing to-do list. We are praying for wisdom as we look into homeschooling options, medical insurance and various other details with this new step. At one point we both asked each other if we were really ready to take this "jump." We concluded that though on our own, we were not, obviously God was -- so here we go!

Soon after, I was contacted by a Pastor who wanted to know if I would be available to participate in his mission's conference later this month! What a surprise to actually be contacted by a pastor! (I have another fellow missionary to thank for this contact, and am rejoicing at another opportunity to share our ministry.)

In addition, we had another church partner with us this month bringing us that much closer to the field. God has been so good to our family. With every step we take, He seems to carry us the next five. I pray we never take these moments for granted.

Thank you so much for your continued prayer support. You too are working to reach the Welsh with the Gospel of Christ, and Michelle and I are forever grateful for your ministry of prayer.
