Last month I started reading through the Bible in chronological order, which puts me in the Book of Job about halfway through Genesis. The first 37 chapters (the testing allowed by God and that inflicted by Job's "friends") can be somewhat discouraging. God allows Satan himself to test Job's blameless faithfulness—his wealth disappears, his children all die, his health is taken away, and his wife suggests that he curse God and end his life. Then along come four of his buddies to comfort him, who sit in silence with him for a week, and then proceed to offer their opinions on why all of this has to be Job's own fault. Through it all, Job remained blameless before God, although he couldn't explain the reason for his trial. Finally, in Chapter 38, God answers out of the whirlwind and reminds him personally that He was there all along, that He is intimately aware of all that happens within His creation (including things that mankind knows nothing about), and that He is in control! What a blessing, to be reminded that He who clothes each blade of grass, and feeds the birds of the air, is mindful of the likes of sinners like us! He will never leave us nor forsake us, but in His sovereignty He sometimes allows us to be tested. During these tests, we have the opportunity to praise God for His goodness, and lean upon His everlasting arms for strength to do what must be done. "But He knoweth the way that I take: when He hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold." —Job 23.10
